We are delighted to be collaborating with *Plantation Teas* of Hong Kong.

Founded by Nana Chan and a team of tea lovers, they source single origin, whole leaf teas in small batches from family farms in China and Taiwan.

- JASMINE PHOENIX PEARLS** 5.5
 Fujian, China (福建銀針 FUJIAN SILVER NEEDLE) °
Produced in Guangxi, the home of Jasmine flowers, with premium grade green tea from Fujian. Pearl shaped, it gives a rounder flavour than a loose leaf Jasmine. It is scented using the traditional method of layering the green tea leaves with fresh jasmine blossoms seven times.
- ORCHID TIEGUANYIN** 5
 Fujian, China (紅心歪尾桃 Hongxin Waiweitao) °°
Grown on a small family farm situated in Anxi, the birthplace of "Iron Buddha" tea. Harvested in spring, it undergoes a highly complex processing method where the leaves are rolled into a semi-ball shape for quicker unfurling. A brisk, floral Tieguanyin with fresh notes of winter melon and melon seed.
- ALISHAN HIGH MOUNTAIN OOLONG** 6.5
 Jiayi, Taiwan (青心烏龍 Chin-Shin-Oolong) °°
From a small family farm in Shizhuo (石卓) at 1680m where the tea plants are blanketed in a sea of clouds (雲海) every morning, yielding plumper, juicier leaves. Subtle in flavour and with a buttery texture, every sip is imbued with mountain essence (山頭氣) - like breathing in crisp highland air.
- OSMANTHUS OOLONG** 7.5
 Nantou, Taiwan (青心烏龍 Chin-Shin-Oolong) °°
Katie Yen and her 90%-female team are spearheading organic tea farming methods in Yuchi, central Taiwan. Once processed, the leaves are baked together with osmanthus flowers to absorb the blossoms' essential oils naturally. The blossoms are then separated out by hand before the tea leaves are rolled and finished.
- HONEY ORCHID DANCONG** 7.5
 Guangdong, China (蜜蘭香 Dancong Honey Orchid Scent) °°°
A dramatically aromatic type of oolong from the mineral rich soils of Phoenix Mountain (鳳凰山) in Chaozhou. Honey Orchid Scent is one of the ten signature cultivars of these Phoenix "single bush" teas. Grown on Wudong Mountain, one of the highest in the Phoenix Mountains, it is almost perpetually enshrouded in mist and home to the region's purest tea groves.
- DA HONG PAO** 7
 Fujian, China (奇丹 Qidan) °°°°
"Big Red Robe", grown on the cliffs of Wuyishan, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here mountain streams flow over porous rocks, feeding the soil with minerals, giving the tea the distinctive mineral flavour of rock teas (岩茶). Made by a pioneering women's team led by A Meng. Double charcoal roasted.
- KEEMUN RED** 5
 Anhui, China (祁門檜葉種 Qimen Zhuye Zhong) °°°°°
Grown at 1200m by Mr. Xie, a second generation farmer from one of the leading family producers of Keemun tea in the Guniujiang Natural Reserve area. Keemun is one of the oldest black teas to arrive in the West and prized for the complex, nutty flavours of this delicate small leaf tea. A great food complement.
- PALACE PUERH** 5.5
 Yunnan, China (大葉種 Puerh Assamica) °°°°°
Grown at 1000m in Menghai County, this is a top grade fully fermented ripe Puerh, made only of young buds for a silky, velvety texture and subtle woody notes. Most ripe Puerh is produced from the leftovers of raw Puerh production. This comes from a family in Yunnan who are dedicated to perfecting ripe Puerh in its own right.

THE JADE GROSS COLLECTION

A native of Hong Kong, Jade Gross has had an intriguing journey into wine, a polymath seeking her highest sense of purpose. Having studied cookery in Paris with a James Beard Scholarship, Jade has worked in some of the great kitchens of Europe – Alain Ducasse au Plaza Athénée, D.O.M. in Sao Paulo, El Cellar di Can Roca in Girona, and finally Mugaritz, where she steadily climbed the ranks all the way from intern to Head Chef, and then leading their R&D kitchen, all before the age of 26.

Feeling that she had accomplished as much as she could in the world of cuisine, and wanting a new challenge, she set off on a new adventure. Befriending local winemakers in Rioja, notably Abel Mendoza, and falling in love with the region, she settled in the small Spanish town of San Vicente de la Sonsierra in Rioja Alta nestled in between the two parts of Rioja Alavesa. Her cellar is just outside the village, a short walk from Abel’s own winery, and their influence on each other’s ideas and styles is striking.

Jade launched her label in 2019, buying some Tempranillo grapes from a 34 year old vineyard, and quickly found her wines selling out. In 2020, she continued working with a grower from San Vicente, while also buying a vineyard in Labastida, at about 600m. elevation.

Jade is one of the bright young talents in Rioja’s “third way”: eschewing the region’s monolithic style and methods, and re-grounding its winemaking in terroir. Across the entire range, these are very modern wines, gastronomic and fresh, and blazing a new trail for Rioja winemakers, away from classification and ageing, and focused instead on site, soil and exquisite flavour.
